## Football Notes

Swinton visit Fartown to-day in the semi-final of the Rugby League Cup and we are expecting a great struggle to take place. They have shewn consistent form this season and are worthy of their position as third Club in the league.

During the last six weeks a great race for a position in the top-four has been witnessed with certain Clubs. Wigan experienced a severe slump during that period, for their team had played brilliantly up to then and held the first position, with Hull following close at their heels, and Hudd., Oldham, Swinton, Leeds and Hull K.R. not far behind, the ultimate positions of these Clubs after the completion of all league matches was very much in doubt.

Hull have rightly earned the honour of being league leaders and their match with their neighbours from Craven Park should prove a great attraction at the Boulevard. If the Rovers display the form they showed against us a week or two ago, Hull will find that they are up against it, for the Boulevard team have had some stiff Clubs to contend with recently, and on Saturday last in their Cup-tie with Wigan it was evident they were a tired team.

Our match to-day is of great importance, three Cups have been lost, and our remaining hope is the League Cup, and the team will have to show a great improvement on recent displays if they intend to win this trophy.

Swinton are possessed of young, speedy backs, and it will require all the cleverness of our men to frustrate their attacks. Every member of the team must give of his best to-day.

At the Hull v. Wigan match last Saturday the attendance was 22,064, this figure fell far short of the record—31,494 on the occasion of the Huddersfield v. Oldham Cup-Tie on March 12th, 1921.

Another good crowd is expected to-day, as Swinton do not often put in an appearance at Fartown, their last visit being on Feb. 21st, 1920, when we entertained them in the 1st Round of the N.U. Cup, the result on that day was Hudd. 19 pts., Swinton, 0.
