PEPPERELL CHRONOLOGY AT FARTOWN.

1934 Oct. 27—Stanley first wore the claret and gold jersey v. Rochdale Hornets Reserves at Fartown. Was signed after the match.

Dec. 15—Stanley's first team debut v. Dewsbury at Fartown.

1936 Sept. 5—Stanley scored 21 points v. Newcastle (a).

Sept. 26—Stanley scored 20 points against Hunslet at Fartown.

Nov. —Stanley went on a French tour with the Huddersfield team, playing at Bordeaux and Paris.

1937 Oct. 30—Stanley played in his first Yorkshire Cup Final v. Leeds at Wakefield —on the losing side.

1938 Oct. 22—Stanley won a Yorkshire Cup medal when Hull were beaten in the Final at Odsal.

Dec. 1—Russell signed.

Dec. 3—Stanley kicked his 100th goal for Huddersfield in a game at St. Helens.

1939 Sept. 23—Russell's first team debut (at full back) v. Bradford (a).

1940 May 13—By failing to play at Wakefield, Stanley brought to a close a run of 70 consecutive first team appearances.

1942 Aug. 29—Albert's first team debut in a charity cup game v. Halifax at Fartown. Stanley and Russell also turned out.

Nov. 28 & Dec. 5—Yorkshire Cup Final v. Dewsbury. Russell played in the first leg only. Stanley in the second leg only.

1943 Oct. 23—Albert signed on for Huddersfield.

Nov. 20—Stanley scored his 100th try in all matches for the club.

1945 Apl. 28 & May 5—Albert played in the R.L. Challenge Cup Final in which Huddersfield beat Bradford both at Fartown and Odsal.

1946 Jan. 30—Albert transferred to Workington Town.

1947 Nov. 8—Stanley's Testimonial Match
