OFFICIAL NOTES.

To-day we reach a high-spot in our season's programme when we entertain the 1947-48 New Zealand League Kiwis. We give them, one and all, a very hearty welcome to Fartown and hope to see the playing members of the side demonstrate something of the form which enabled them to defeat Great Britain in the second Test, Wales, Wigan and others of our leading club teams. In such an event a treat will be in store for spectators this afternoon.

After the match our President (Mr. H. V. Wood, F.C.A., J.P.) will entertain both teams and officials to a Dinner at the Masonic Hall, Greenhead Road.

The first New Zealand visitors to Fartown were a side of Maoris who beat Huddersfield by 2 goals, 1 try and 5 minors to 2 goals and 1 minor. This game took place on January 7th, 1889. A. H. Baskerville's "Pioneers" gave us our first sight of Edgar Wrigley, Con Byrne and W. M. Trevarthen. They came to Fartown

on October 12th, 1907, and won by 19 points to 8. The first Huddersfield win over a New Zealand Touring Team was against the 1926-27 "All Blacks" on November 6th, 1926, the score being 12-10 in our favour. Can we improve on that to-day?

P. A. SMITH (prop forward). Age 30, weight 15st. Represented Canterbury League, 1943-44-45-46-47; South Island League, 1944-45-46-47; Capt. Canterbury, 1944-45-46-47; Capt. South Island, 1946-47; New Zealand 1946-47; Capt. 1947. Represented (Rugby Union) Wellington, 1940-41; Canterbury, 1942.

KEN MOUNTFORD (loose forward). Age 23. Represented South Island, 1943-44-45-46-47; West Coast, 1940-41-42-43-44-45-46-47. Played for West Coast at 16 years of age. Brother of Wigan's Ces. Mountford.

C. C. HANCOX (second row forward). Represented King Country at 18 years of age from 1937 to 1945. Played in All Black Trials, 1939. Also played for North Island Minor Union Team same year. Represented North Auckland, 1946. Turned down All Black Trials, 1947, to play League.

C. McBRIDE (second row forward). Age 22, weight 13st. 4lbs. First played Senior football at 19 years of age, 1944. Represented West Coast, 1944-45-46-47; South Island, 1945-46-47; New Zealand (Test Match), 1946. Plays for Blackball Club, West Coast, South Island. Home town, Greymouth.

M. W. ROBERTSON (three-quarter). Age 22, weight 11st. 12lbs., height 5ft 11in. Played Senior League at 19 years of age. Represented Auckland in 1945-46-47; and played against England in the Test last year. Made the North Island Team in 1947 and was a member of the Richmond Team that beat Balmain in 1946.

A. J. McINNARNEY (wing three-quarter). Age 28, weight 12st. 7lbs. Started to play Senior football, 1938. Represented Auckland, 1938-39-40-41-47; New Zealand, 1939 English Tour; North Island, 1947.

T. H. HARDWICK (loose forward). Age 24, weight 13st. 3lbs., height 6ft. Started playing Senior Rugby Union while serving in the New Zealand Army in 1941. On demobilisation in 1944 began playing Rugby League for Ponsonby Club, whom he captained 1946-47. Represented Auckland, 1944-45-46-47; North Island, 1945-47; New Zealand, 1946-47.

J. NEWTON (second row forward). Age 27, weight 14st. 4lbs., height 6ft. 2in. Started playing senior Rugby League in 1937. Represented West Coast, 1937-38-39-40-42-43-44-45-46-47; South Island, 1939-44-45-46-47; New Zealand, 1946-47.

W. S. CLARKE (full back). Age 27, weight 11st. 13lbs. Represented Auckland, 1940-41-43-44-45-46; Pakehas v. Maoris, 1940-41-43-44-45-46-47; Wellington Rugby Union v. Tank Brigade, 1942; Auckland v. Englishmen, 1946 (twice); New Zealand v. Englishmen in Test, 1946. Holds goal-kicking record for New Zealand of 111 goals, established in 1947.

J. A. FORREST (wing three-quarter). Age 23 years, weight 12st. 5lbs. Club, Runanga. Represented West Coast, South Island, 1944-47.

L. R. JORDAN (centre three-quarter). Age 27, weight 12st. 3lbs., height 5ft. 9in. First played Senior football, 1939. Represented Auckland, 1940-41-45-46-47; North Island, 1946-47; New Zealand, 1946.

J. J. JOHNSON (front row forward). Age 29, weight 15st., height 6ft. First played Senior football, 1942. Represented Auckland, 1946-47.

R. CUNNINGHAM (scrum half). Age 23, height 5ft 8in., weight 11st. 6lbs. Plays for City Club, Auckland. Represented Auckland, 1945-46-47; New Zealand, 1946.

L. R. PYE (front row forward). Age 30, weight 15st. 3lbs., height 6ft. 1in. Represented Manawata and Wanganui Province at Rugby; Second N.Z.E.F., Division XV, Middle East, 1941-42-43.
