OFFICIAL NOTES

Victories over Castleford and York maintain our unbeaten certificate, and today we turn aside from league affairs to enter upon the first round of the Yorkshire Challenge Cup. We last won this trophy just ten years ago, so it is high time it was brought to Fartown once again.

Our being drawn with the Yorkshire County Amateurs has provided a meeting of David and Goliath, and unless there is a vast upheaval of form we should be able to count on a place in the second round draw. There will be Fartowners present this afternoon who could tell us how Ebbw Vale once came to Huddersfield and beat the "claret and gold" against all odds, and many of us will remember Sharlston Rovers beating Workington Town in a cup-tie only a season or two ago.

Yet we look confidently for a comfortable Fartown victory today and in the second leg which will be played at Dewsbury next Thursday, kick-off at 6 p.m.

Cracknell, our "A" team winger, who has been chosen for the Amateurs today is serving in H.M. Forces and there is some slight doubt about his being able to play. Cracknell himself is very keen and will be very disappointed if he is unable to get here. West and Minton both played for England Amateurs v. France during 1947-48, and also played in the County Amateur team. Ramsden, Wilson and Keeble have also played for the County Amateurs. Hemingway played in the R.L. Cup-tie against Dewsbury last season.

Owing to this afternoon's cup-tie clashing with our "A" team game against Hunslet, the latter will be played this evening, commencing at 6 o'clock.

All postal applications must be accompanied by remittance and stamped addressed envelope, sent to A. Archbell, Secretary.

Prices are: Stand (reserved and numbered), 7/6 and 5/-; Paddock, 4/-; West Stand, 3/-; Ground, 2/-. Club Secretaries and Works Canteen Supervisors are invited to apply for bulk allocations of the ground tickets.

September 18th will be a big day in Fartown history, and followers are

advised to get their tickets in good time. It is anticipated that by the time these notes are in print all the Main Stand tickets will have been sold.
