OFFICIAL NOTES

After a lapse of four weeks we are back at Fartown again, as Yorkshire Cup winners but with a little leeway to make up in the League. There is no need to stress the importance of today's match. Leeds are at present placed third in the League table and Headingley folk believe that at long last they are going to win the Championship this season.

It seems well-nigh incredible that Leeds should never have gained the Championship Cup in their long history. Like ourselves they have always gone out for the best players, regardless of distance or cost, and some of the best remembered names in Rugby League football have worn the Leeds colours. Yet the Championship Trophy has always eluded their grasp.

Five times have they reached the Final Play-off, only to fail on each occasion, and in three of these Finals we provided the

successful opposition. So today's meeting promises a thrilling struggle with both sides eager for the vital points that will advance First Four prospects and in addition count in the Yorkshire League table.

This afternoon also has an importance all its own for Bob Nicholson, our popular Cumbrian forward, who has selected the visit of Leeds as his Testimonial Match. It is over eleven years since Bob signed on for us and although the War cut a big slice out of his career he has achieved most of the honours the game has to offer.

The story of his achievements is told in his Testimonial Book and need not be repeated here. But we can say that Bob has always been a credit to the game and to his club. His repeated selection for his country and his county did not alter his outlook and wherever he has been playing, whether in England, Wales, France,

Australia or New Zealand, he has always worthily upheld the high traditions expected of a Fartowner.

We do ask all present at Fartown this afternoon to subscribe generously to the collecting boxes which will be sent round, and also to the "Mile of Pennies" Effort. The latter is still well short of its target but we hope to reach the Milestone this afternoon.

Recent Events

The outstanding event of the past few weeks has, of course, been the Yorkshire Challenge Cup Final. We heartily congratulate our players on their success at Headingley a fortnight ago. Bowden had a penalty goal on the board almost, it seemed, before the game had started, but before long we were in arrears. Then came the Banks-Pepperell move which produced a try to the latter, and with

Bowden goaling we were ahead at half-time.

After the interval Bowden repeated his first half feat of landing a penalty in the opening minute. Another try from the Banks-Pepperell combine and two further goals to Bowden gave us a comfortable lead and made the issue safe. We have had a long time to wait for this Trophy—it is twelve years since we last won it—but maybe such a lengthy period will not be allowed to elapse before we bring it to Fartown again.

Our League aspirations suffered a setback at Hull last Saturday. Victory would have taken us into the fourth place, but our defeat by a margin of two points means that we slip back to the seventh position.
