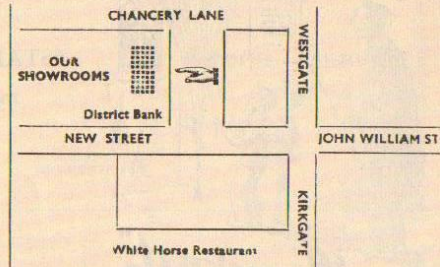

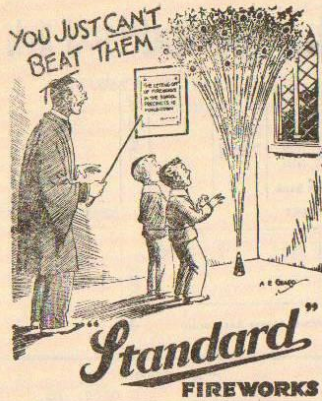

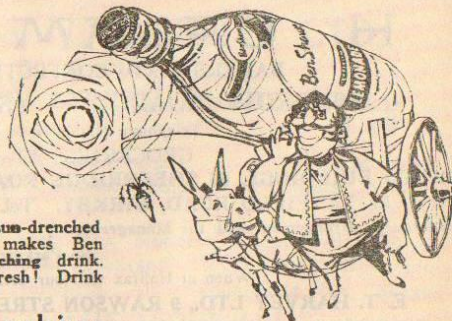

FARTOWNERS PAST AND PRESENT

No. 25 — Mick Sullivan

Mick first wore our claret and gold jersey in an "A" team game against Hull at Fartown in August, 1951. He signed professional forms in May, 1952, and made his first team debut at Dewsbury the following October.

He jumped into the international limelight by playing a great part in Gt. Britain's sensational 1954 World Cup win. So consistent was his wing play that he was chosen in 39 consecutive Tests for Great Britain, and although left out of this season's First Test team v. New Zealand he was recalled for the Second and Third. His full total of representative games now tops the 60 mark.

It was a great disappointment to Fartowners when he asked to be put on the transfer list in October, 1957. Wigan quickly snapped him up at the then-record fee of £9,500.

January, 1961, saw another big sum change hands when Mick signed for St. Helens—£11,000 this time.

As a Fartowner, Mick scored 103 tries in 125 first team appearances, and 76 tries in 75 "A" team games.

His full total of tries in senior football to date, including tours and representative games is 301

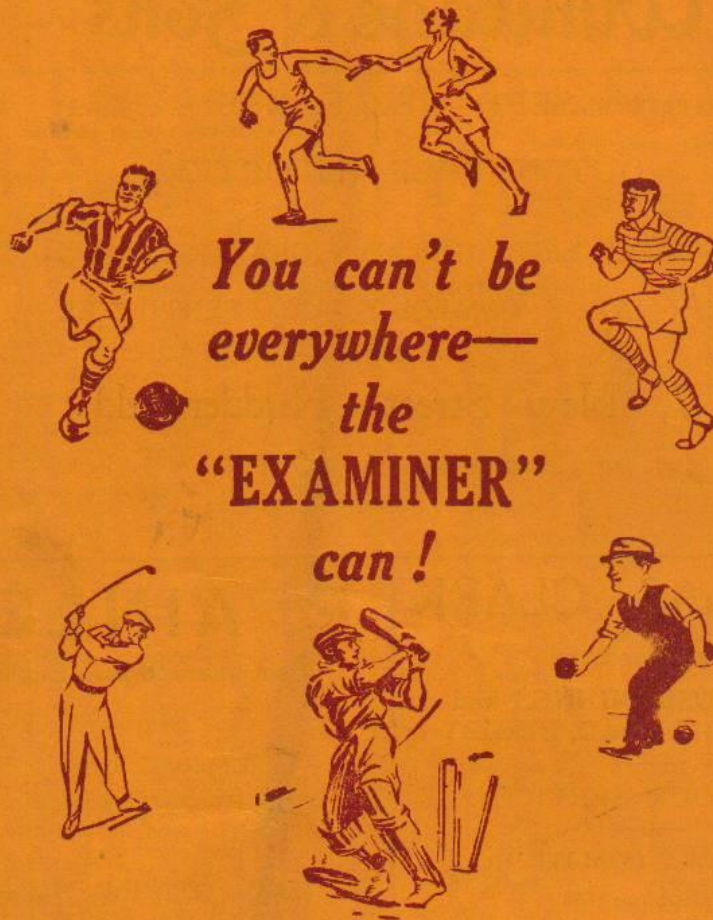
