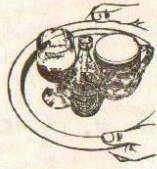

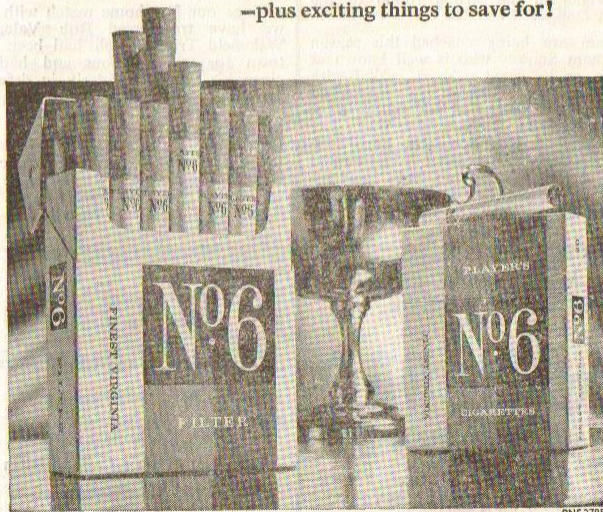

Player of the Match awards

Players No. 6 Match Awards, with an independent judge attending all League matches, continues exactly as last season. At the end of each game the 'player of the match' receives £6 and 3 points, whilst the players rated second and third receive 2 pts. and 1 pt. respectively. At the end of the season the six players with the most points will share £600 prize money, of which £250 (and trophy) will go to the 'player of the year.'

In place of the former Spectators' Champion Award scheme, a new competition is to take place based on a team's goal-kicking ability. This will provide extra

entertainment for spectators and extra finance for teams.

This goal-kicking competition will take place once at each club throughout the season. The two teams involved will elect a goal-kicker who, during the interval, will each have six attempts to kick goals in the established R.L. manner. Three attempts will be made from each end of the ground, in all cases the ball being placed on the 25-yard line. One attempt from the right hand touch line, one from the centre and one from the left hand touch line, with a repeat at the other end of the ground.

For each successful kick the team will be awarded £6. If the kicker kicks all six the prize money will be doubled, i.e. the total can be £72 for each team.
