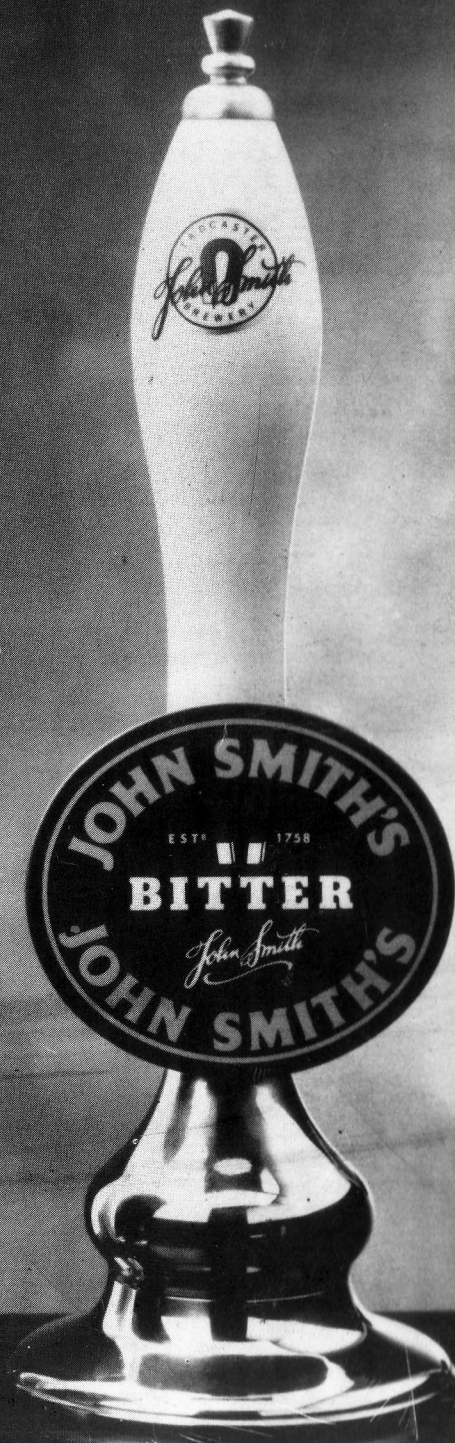

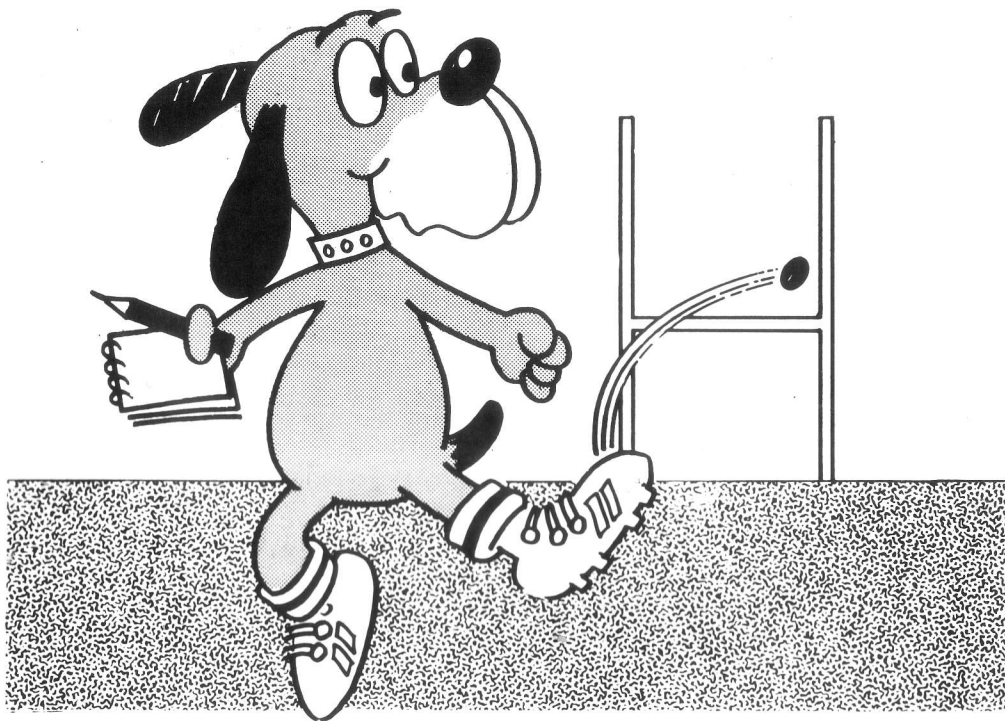

Like most Clubs there hasn't been a lot of transfer activity during the close season, the prime factor being the lack of cash all round the game.

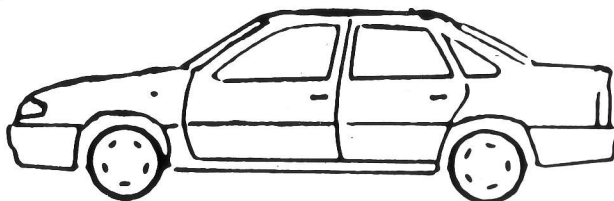

## FLASHBACK

The two clubs met in the first round of last season's Yorkshire Cup. This report taken from "LEAGUE EXPRESS" should bring back some memories. Let's hope for a similar result today.

Who was the Fartown number 12? — A new signing?

### **MURPHY MAGIC** Huddersfield 28 Ryedale-York 10

Alex Murphy worked the magic to help Huddersfield to a place in the second round of the Yorkshire Cup, the first time for seven years.

Murphy, wanted to fill the coaching vacancy at Fartown, watched yesterday's match as a guest from the stand, but agreed to deliver a half-time pep talk as Huddersfield trailed 10-nil.

And it worked wonders as the Fartowners shook off their first half lethargy and ran in 28 second-half points without reply in a remarkable transformation.

"I just told them to go back to playing basic football and they did", he said. "It was a great effort in the second half, there was lots of commitment".

Murphy, who plans to talk to Keighley later today has promised Huddersfield an answer by the middle of the week but the Fartown Board are now even more desperate to land their man.

The Fartowners looked completely out of it when Ryedale-York, more positive and workman-like broke half an hours deadlock to run in tries by centres Wayne Pagdin and Nick Pinkney and a goal from loose forward Nick Ramsden to lead 10-nil by the interval.

But Huddersfield were a different side after the break. With acting coaches Brendan White and Greg Shuttleworth, who was named John Smiths' Man of the Match, setting superb leads, they created openings galore.

Centre Ian Thomas crossed for two tries to take his tally to 5 in 4 matches and others came from Joe Naidole, Howard Boothroyd and Paul Meillam, while Simon Kenworthy kicked four goals.

Ryedale-York had no answer to the onslaught and full back Graham Sullivan, who went off in the 13th minute with a leg injury but returned early in the second half, was unable to maintain his record as the League's longest point scorer. His run came to an end after 32 matches, as Huddersfield claimed a memorable victory.

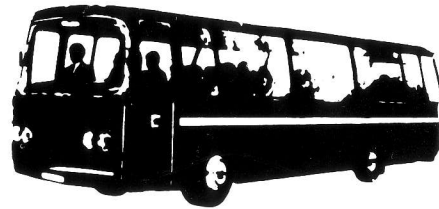

### **THE FLYERS — ON THE MOVE WITH FARTOWN**

### **NEW PUBLICATION**

A new book, "Harold Bowman On Tour Down Under", tells the story of Hull Rugby League Club forward Harold Bowman who had the rare good sense to keep diaries on the seven week voyage, photographs, match reports, social activities, match programmes and newspaper cuttings from home and abroad when he was selected to tour Australia and New Zealand with the England Rugby League parties in 1924 and 1928.

His grandson, David, discovered the photographs and documents kept by his late grandfather and contacted Michael Ulyatt, who had already compiled three books on Rugby League, "A Centenary History of Hull Kingston Rovers", "Old Faithful — A History of Hull F.C." and "Hull — A Divided City — The Complete Story of Derby Matches between Hull F.C. and Hull K.R."
