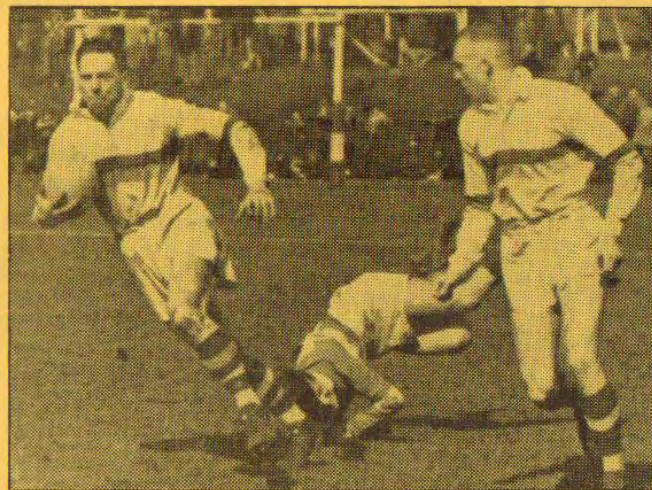

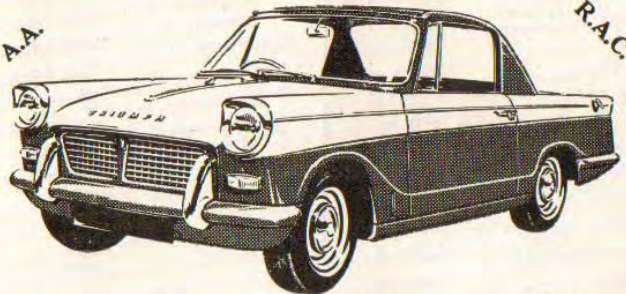

In Retrospect

THANKS to two successful runs of victories the final records for 1959-60 made much more pleasant reading than the previous season's figures had done. After losing their opening League fixture at Whitehaven the team won each of the next seven games. Then, after a disappointing home defeat at the hands of Leigh early in December, they won eight consecutive matches.

A high standard of team spirit was reached in this mid-season spell, every man doing his own job while being ready to cover a team-mate. This feature played a great part in enabling the Fartowners to be in a position to challenge for Top Four honours by the end of February. Unfortunately the challenge was not maintained. Three defeats in March saw the hard-earned ground lost, and of the season's last ten matches only two were won.

A welcome return to the team was made by Tommy Smales, who had missed all the previous season's games after sustaining a badly injured arm in the Halifax "friendly." His "come-back" was also in the opening game against the "blue and whites"—and once again he was carried off, this time with a leg injury. Fortunately it was not serious and after missing a couple of games he went through the full programme to lead the try-scorers and strike up a sound partnership with Don Lockwood.

Ernie Ashcroft made most appearances. He missed only one game and led the team well.

Frank Dyson too, had a good season. He reached his century of goals (for the 4th time), played for Great Britain in a Test v. Australia, and captained Yorkshire once again. Brian Curry, as Ashcroft's centre partner, did much sound work and proved a useful deputy goal-kicker.

Mike Wicks made an outstanding entry into R.L. football with nine tries in his first three games. Then came the accident to a bone in his neck which kept him out of action for five months. Many felt that Mike, in his eagerness to be back on the field, returned too soon. But return he did, to finish the season with 20 tries from 20 games and the promise of more to come.

Aidan Breen filled a wing position during both the successful spells, while Athol Brown and Roland Barrow also gave good service on the flank at different periods.

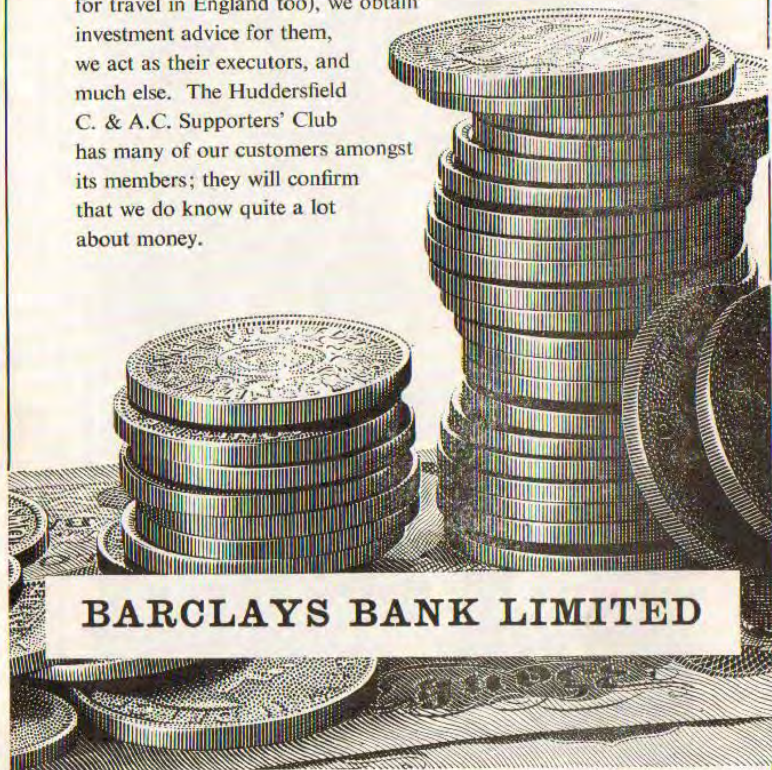
Nineteen different forwards were called upon. Jack Fairbank was a regular up to the time of his transfer to Leeds, while Kilroy and Clarke met with injuries when they were bidding for a place in the pack. Wood shared the hooking honours with Close, and there was consistent work from such as Ted Slevin, Dave Flint, George Killen, Brian Shacklady and Peter Ramsden during that middle-of-the-season period.

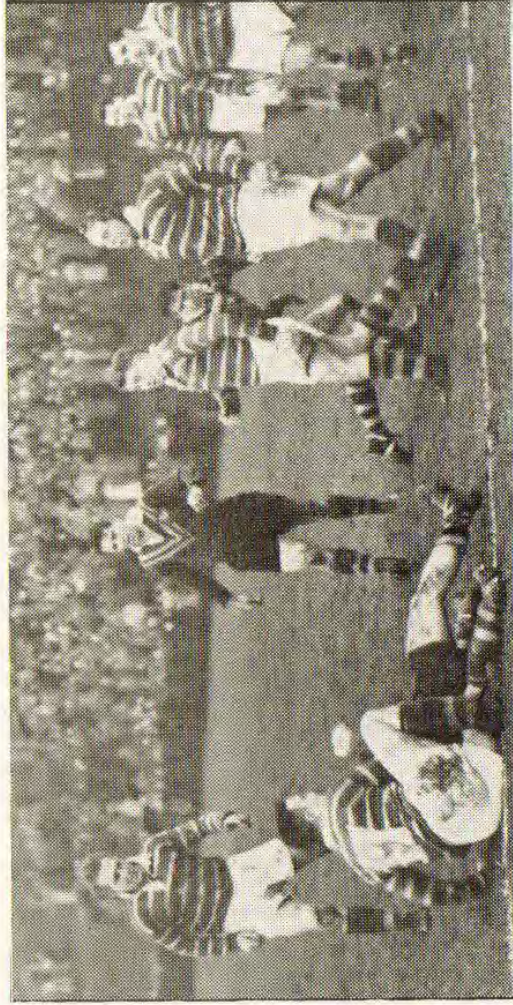

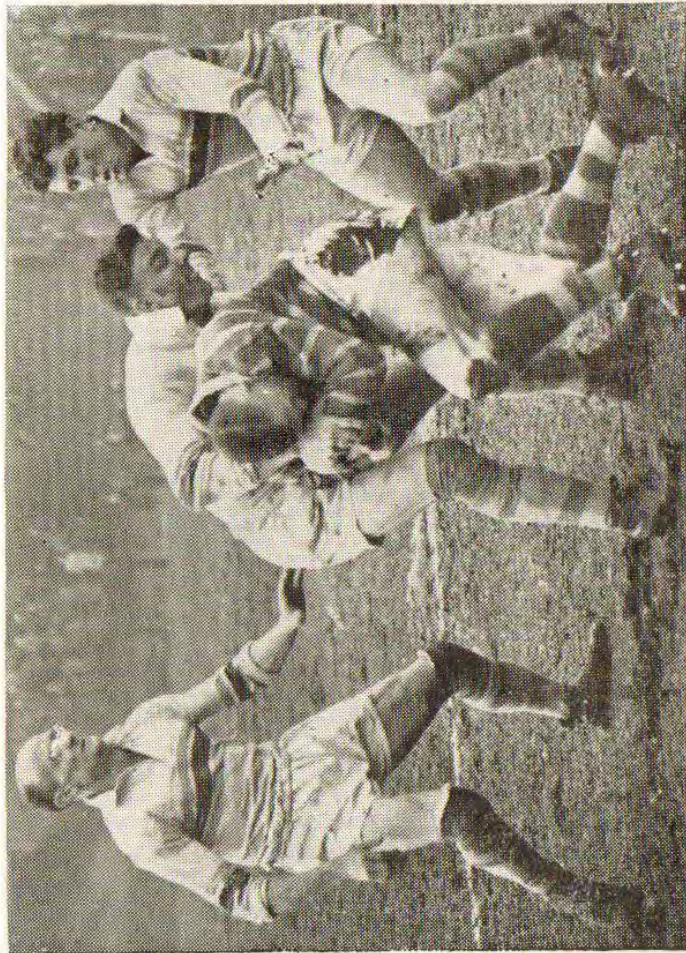

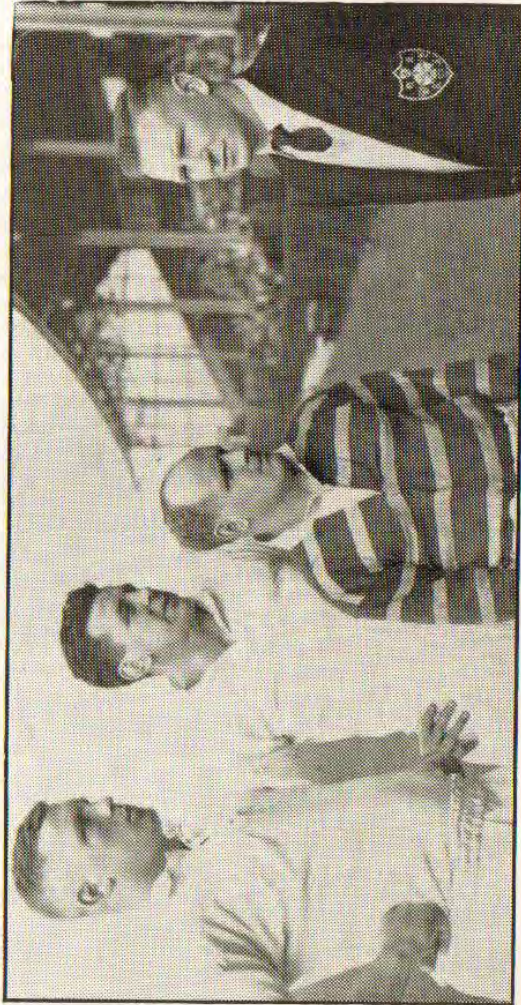

In recent years he served on many of the Club's committees and at the present time is a vice-president.





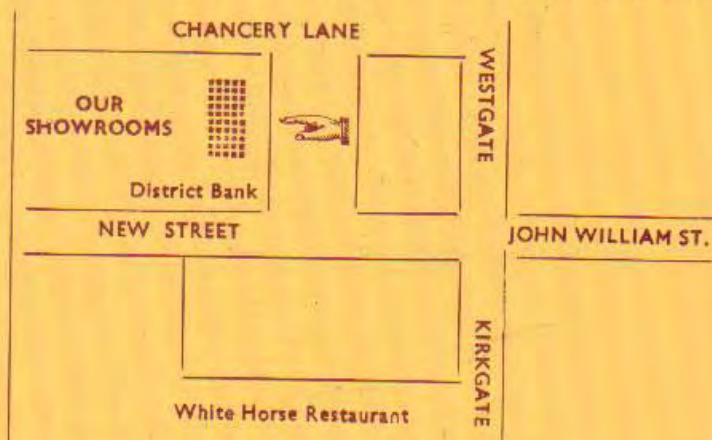
