A Message from the Chairman of the Football Committee

1967/68 season sees Fartown taking another step to once again becoming a leading figure in Rugby League with the installation of floodlights.

Owing to the financial position of the club being precarious over the last few seasons, the decision to spend money on lights was a very difficult one to make as it was felt by quite a lot of people that any money available should be spent on strengthening the playing staff. It was, however, decided that floodlights should be installed.

With regard to the playing staff, Mr. Harry Street was appointed prior to the beginning of the season as coach and trainer, and with his vast knowledge both as a player and coach we are hoping for a very successful season. Mr. Raymond Haywood has been appointed 'A' team coach and up to present several junior players have been signed. We did apply to the Huddersfield and District Amateur Rugby League for permission to run an under 19 'B' team but unfortunately this was turned down by that body. We are still, however, pursuing the possibility of running a Junior Side at Fartown.

We are also leaving no stone unturned in our efforts to strengthen the side during the season and all efforts will be made by the Football Committee to sign the right type of player. Already deputations have been into South Wales to see recommendations but at the time of writing no direct signings have been made.

In conclusion, I would like to say how proud I am to have been appointed Chairman of the Football Committee and would like to wish the players, the coaches and the Backroom Workers at Fartown a most successful season.

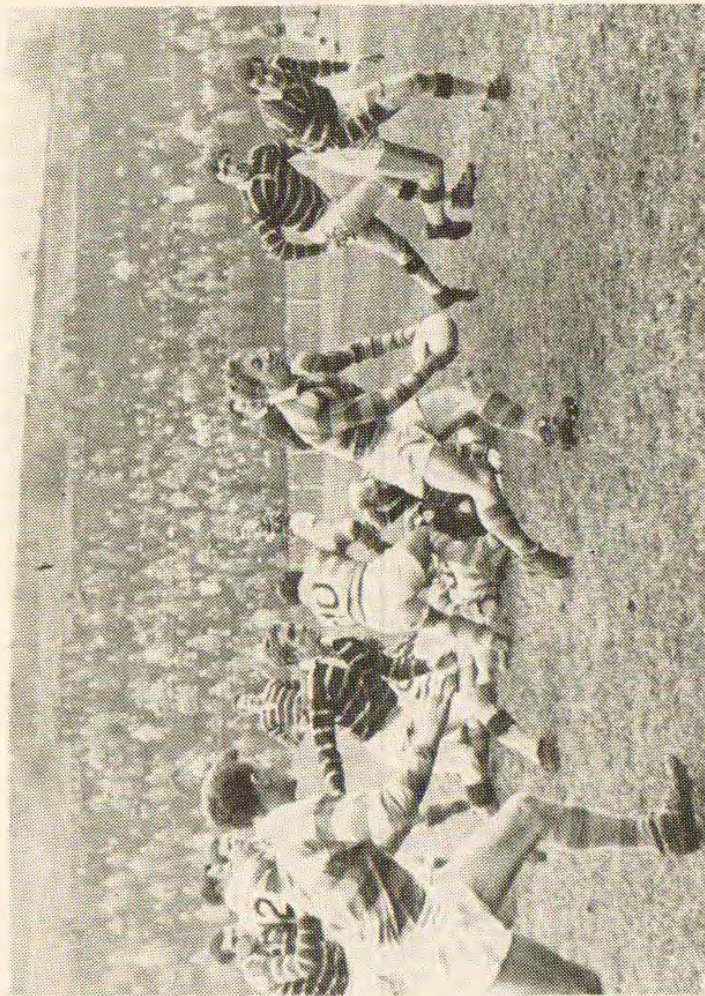


In season 1914-15, All Four major Rugby League Trophies were won by Huddersfield.

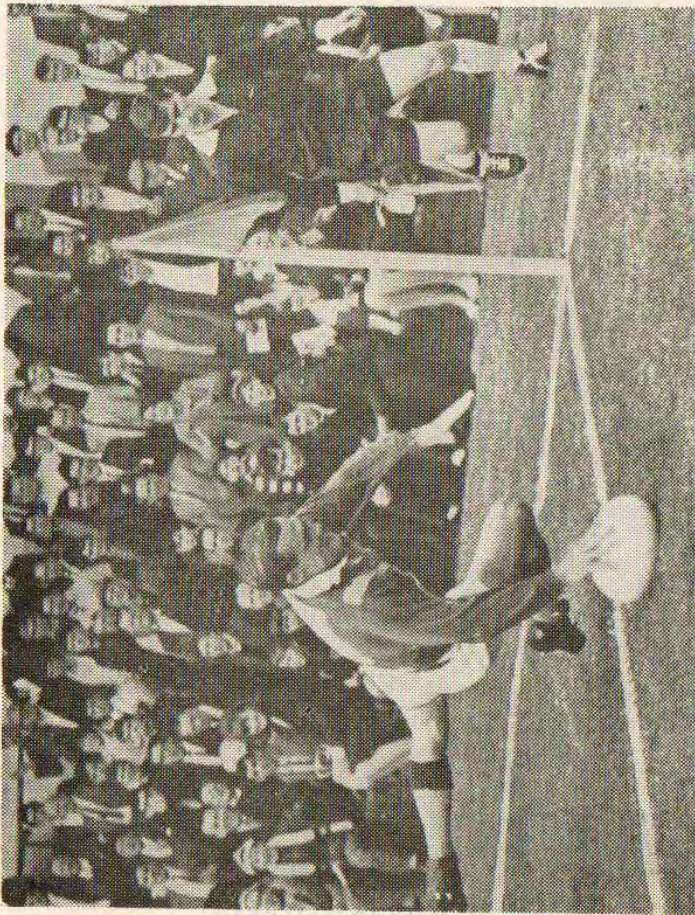
